CACHE Level 3 Certificate in Assessing Vocational Achievement

What does the qualification cover?

The principles and practices of assessment, assessing occupational competence in the work environment and assessing vocational skills, knowledge and understanding

When can I start?

Thursday 25 February, 3, 10 and 17 March 2016, 9am – 4pm at Kingsland Employment and Skills Hub, Parkside Drive, Houghton Regis, LU5 5PY

Who is it suitable for?

Anyone who would like to assess learners in the working environment, and has access to two learners wanting to achieve qualifications. Qualifications offered include: Childcare, Youth Work, Learning and Development, Advice and Guidance, Playwork, Business Administration, Supporting Teaching and Learning and Work with Parents.

What are the entry requirements?

You must be at least 19 years old, have a relevant level 3 qualification and be competent in the area you are planning to assess.

How is it completed?

By attending the four taught sessions detailed above, supporting your two learners through their qualification, completing written tasks and being observed in the workplace

How long does it take to complete?

You can usually complete it in 9-12 months.

What can I do next?

- A higher level related qualification

How much does it cost?

- £725

Payment by instalments can be arranged; alternatively you may be eligible for an Advanced Learner Loan to cover the full cost of the qualification.
