What does the qualification cover?

The skills and knowledge required to provide sustained, intense, whole family support in a variety of settings.

When can I start?

Induction:

- Thursday 20 April 2017 9:00am – 1:00pm

Tutored sessions:

- Tuesday 25 & Thursday 27 April 2017 9:00am – 4:30pm
- Thursday 4, 11, 18 & 25 May 2017 9:00am – 4:30pm
- Thursday 8 June 2017 9:00am – 4.30pm

All sessions must be attended

Venue: Kingsland Employment and Skills Hub, Parkside Drive, Houghton Regis, LU5 5PY.

Who is it suitable for?

Anyone delivering intense support to families with multiple and complex needs for a minimum of 15 hours per week.

What are the entry requirements?

You must be at least 16 years old.

How is it completed?

By attending the 8 taught sessions detailed above, completing written tasks and being observed in the workplace.

How long does it take to complete?

Up to 6 months.

What can I do next?

- Level 5 Diploma in Leadership for Health and Social Care and Children and Young People's Services
- A related degree
- Apply for family/parent support practitioner roles

How much does it cost?

- £162.50 to those working in Central Bedfordshire
- £650 for applicants from other areas
