What does the qualification cover?

The knowledge and skills required when working directly with children or young people in schools.

When can I start?

Any time

Who is it suitable for?

Anyone working in roles that offer specialist support for pupils' learning for a minimum of 15 hours per week.

What are the entry requirements?

You must be at least 16 years old.

How is it completed?

By attending courses, completing e-learning, written tasks and being observed in the workplace.

How long does it take to complete?

Up to 15 months

What can I do next?

- A related degree
- Apply for senior or specialist teaching assistant roles

How much does it cost?

- £2,200
