What does the unit cover?

This accredited Level 3 CPD unit is for workers who are Special Educational Needs Co-ordinators (SENCo) in early years settings and would like recognition for this important role.

When can I start?

Who is it suitable for?

SENCoS who hold a relevant Level 3 childcare qualification, have previously attended SENCo training, and regularly attend Professional Study Group (PSG) meetings.

What are the entry requirements?

You should be at least 16 years old and have a minimum of one year's experience in the SENCo role. You must also work in setting for a minimum of 7 hours per week, you should be actively working as the SENCO, have a history of records that support this role and work in partnership with parents and other professionals to support the child/young person.

How is it completed?

By attending the taught session detailed above, completing written tasks and being observed in the workplace.

How long does it take to complete?

Up to 3 months.
