# CACHE Unit CYPOP6 Support Disabled Children and Young People and those with Specific Needs

### What does the unit cover?

It covers topics such as the principles of working inclusively with families of children/ young people with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND); how to support age and developmentally appropriate learning, play or leisure opportunities; how to evaluate, support and develop existing practice and how to work in partnership with other agencies and professionals to support provision for disabled children and young people and those with specific requirements.

### Who is it suitable for?

You'll need to be working directly with SEND children or young people, perhaps as a 1:1 support worker or with groups and have some involvement in writing, implementing or reviewing SEND support and or Education, Health & Care (EHC) plans.

### What are the entry requirements?

You should be at least 16 years old and working directly with SEND children for a minimum of 7 hours per week.



## How is it completed?

You'll start the unit by attending the taught course. Your assessor will set you written tasks to complete, observe your practice in the workplace and review how you have developed practice in your setting.

## How long does it take to complete?

Around 3 months.

### What can I do next?

- Level 3 Diploma for the Early Years Workforce or other related Level 3 qualifications.
- Level 4 certificate for the Advanced Practitioner.
- Level 5 Diploma in Leadership for Health and Social Care and Children and Young People's Settings.

# How much does this qualification cost?

- £48.75 to those working in a Central Bedfordshire with early years setting
- £195 for applicants from other areas and those who work with other age groups.
