NCFE CACHE Level 4 Certificate for the Advanced Practitioner in Schools and College

What does the qualification cover?

This Level 4 qualification aims to provide professional development opportunities for practitioners working in the school and college workforce.

Learners will acquire and use skills of leadership, mentoring, coaching and reflection as they complete the qualification through work-based learning opportunities.

Learners will be required to reflect on practice throughout the qualification.

The units that will be covered within the qualification are:

1. Enabling individuals to learn
2. Understand how to support children and young people improve their mental health and wellbeing
3. Working with others to support individuals with additional needs and disability in a school or college
4. Working with families and other professionals in a school or college setting
5. Implementing change in a school or college setting

When can I start?

Anytime.

Who is it suitable for?

Existing practitioners in the school and college workforce, who are looking to acquire and use the skills of leadership, mentoring, coaching and reflection.

What are the entry requirements?

You must be aged 18 or over. You do not need to hold a level 3 qualification, but this would be an advantage. Wealth of experience, knowledge and understanding working in schools or colleges is a requirement for this CPD qualification.

How is it completed?

Through completing e-learning, research, reading and written assignments. There is also a one day course to attend, to support you undertaking an academic research project:

Do I need to be working to take this qualification?

Learners need to be employed or volunteering in a school or college environment for a minimum of 7 hours per week
