What does this qualification cover?

This qualification will support learners to develop specialist knowledge and skills in their area of responsibility and enable learners to promote a values-based culture within their setting.

When can I start?

Who is it suitable for?

This qualification is suitable for those working as a lead practitioner in adult care.

How long will it take to complete this qualification?

The qualification can usually be completed in 12–18 months.

What are the entry requirements?

Learners should be at least 18 years old.

Do you need to be working to take this qualification?

Learners will need to be working, volunteering or on practical placement as they will need to show competence in both knowledge and skills. To successfully complete the course you will need to attend all the taught sessions, complete a series of short tasks and complete some e-learning.

What can I do next?

- This qualification can act as a progression route from the Level 3 Diploma in Adult Care qualification to the Level 5 Diploma in Leadership and Management for Adult Care qualification.
- The qualification also aligns to the Apprenticeship Standard for Lead Practitioner in Adult Care.
