CACHE Level 3 Diploma in Adult Care

What does the qualification cover?

The knowledge and skills needed when working in a senior role with adults in health and social care environments. It covers a wide range of areas including supporting individuals with their physical and emotional care, daily living needs and health care procedures.

It has three pathways:

1. Generic Health and Social Care
2. Dementia
3. Learning Disability

When can I start?

Any time.

Who is it suitable for?

All those who wish to work or are working in an unsupervised role with adults in health and social care environments for a minimum of 15 hours per week.

What are the entry requirements?

You must be at least 16 years old.

How is it completed?

By attending courses, complete e-learning, written tasks and be observed in the workplace.

How long does it take to complete?

Approximately 18 months.

What can I do next?

- The Level 5 Diploma in Leadership for Health and Social Care and Children and Young People's Services (England).
- Gain employment as a senior care support worker or senior healthcare assistant.
