CACHE Level 2 Diploma in Care

What does the qualification cover?

The knowledge and skills needed when working with adults in health and social care environments. It covers a wide range of areas including supporting individuals with their physical and emotional care, daily living needs and health care procedures.

It has three pathways:

1. Generic Health and Social Care
2. Dementia
3. Learning Disability

When can I start?

Any time.

Who is it suitable for?

All those who wish to work or who are working in a supervised role with adults in health and social care.

What are the entry requirements?

You must be at least 16 years old and working or volunteering for a minimum of 7 hours per week.

How is it completed?

By attending courses, completing e-learning, written tasks and being observed in the workplace.

How long does it take to complete?

Approximately 12 months.
