## What does the qualification cover?

This Award prepares learners to work in a school setting and develops the knowledge needed to care for children and adolescents in a way that aids their learning and development at all times. The course covers the skills needed to work in the classroom and fulfil many different roles within the school environment.

## Who is it suitable for?

It's suitable for anyone interested in, or relatively new to a support worker role in a school.

## What are the entry requirements?

There are no requirements as this is an introductory course.
