



# CACHE Level 2 Award in Support Work in Schools

## What does the qualification cover?

The information and knowledge required to work in many varied roles that school support staff may fulfill including, administrative, lunch time supervisor, site support and technical roles as well positions that involve working directly with the children.

## Who is it suitable for?

It's suitable for anyone interested in, or relatively new to a support worker role in a school.

## What are the entry requirements?

There are no requirements as this is an introductory course.

## How is it completed?

You'll need to attend all the taught sessions detailed below, complete e-learning modules and written tasks.

## How long does it take to complete?

Approximately 20 weeks – February to July 2019
