CACHE NCFE Level 3 Award in Supporting Children and Young People's Speech, Language and Communication

What does the qualification cover?

The knowledge and skills required to identify issues and develop speech, language and communication in young children.

When can I start?

Learners can enrol on this qualification at any time.

Who is it suitable for?

Anyone working or volunteering with children or young people, for a minimum of 7 hours per week, who wishes to develop their expertise in this area.

What are the entry requirements?

Learners must be at least 16 years old. There is no requirement to have achieved other childcare related qualifications.

How is it completed?

Learners will be allocated an assessor and will undertake self-guided study with access to a range of electronic materials and online activities. Reflection on real work activities is an important part of this qualification and learners will be supported to contribute to improving quality within their workplace; this will be demonstrated in their portfolio.

The Award consists of two mandatory and one optional unit, and will enable practitioners to develop the knowledge and skills needed to:

- Understand the importance of speech, language and communication
- Identify the signs of those who are experiencing difficulties
- Promote speech, language and communication development
- Explore ways to support children and young people who have speech, language and communication needs (SLCN)

How long does it take to complete?

Around 5 months.
