Level 4 Certificate for the Early Years Advanced Practitioner

What does the qualification cover?

Professional development opportunities for practitioners working in Early Years, including learning about mentoring, coaching and leadership skills, as well as reflection on practice.

When can I start?

Any time – you must be able to attend the training days detailed in next column

Who is it suitable for?

Experienced practitioners, working in an early years setting for a minimum of 7 hours per week, who are looking to further develop their practice.

What are the entry requirements?

You must be at least 18 years old and hold a relevant Level 3 qualification.

How is it completed?

completing e-learning, research, written assignments and reflecting on your existing practice.

Training days:

There are two mandatory training days with this qualification, both 09.30 – 16.00:

PANCo – 19th March, 2020 (Watling House, Dunstable)

Or 23rd September, 2020 (venue to be confirmed)

Research Skills - 13th May 2020 (Priory House, Chicksands)

Or 4th November 2020 (Watling House, Dunstable)
