



NCFE CACHE Level 3 Certificate in Supporting Teaching and Learning

What does the qualification cover?

This qualification provides learners with an understanding of the knowledge needed when working directly with children and young people in a school or college environment. It will enable learners to gain an understanding of elements including children and young people's development, safeguarding their welfare, and communication and professional relationships.

This qualification is aimed at learners working in support roles within schools and colleges.

When can I start?

Any time.

Who is it suitable for?

Anyone working or volunteering with those over the age of 5 years old for a minimum of 7 hours per a week.

What are the entry requirements?

You must be at least 16 years old.

How is it completed?

By attending courses, completing e-learning, written tasks and being observed in the workplace.

How long does it take to complete?

Approximately 12 months.

- Apply for a senior teaching assistant role
