What does the qualification cover?

The Level 2 Certificate in Supporting Teaching and Learning has been designed to provide learners with an understanding of the knowledge and skills needed when working directly with children and young people in school or college environments.

It is aimed at learners working in roles that support pupils' learning in primary, secondary or special schools as well as colleges.

When can I start?

Any time.

Who is it suitable for?

Anyone working or volunteering with those over the age of 5 years old

What are the entry requirements?

You must be at least 16 years old.

How is it completed?

By attending courses, completing e-learning, written tasks and being observed in the workplace.

How long does it take to complete?

Approximately 12 months.
