What does the qualification cover?

As an experienced early years practitioner, this Level 4 Certificate will help to improve your leadership, mentoring and coaching skills as you reflect and develop practice by completing each of the modules below:

- enabling children to learn
- promoting health and wellbeing
- special educational needs
- working with families
- implementing change

When can I start?

There are 5 sessions to attend, you must attend all sessions:

Who is it suitable for?

Level 3 qualified Early Years practitioners looking for your next step, perhaps to develop in your current role or in preparation to take on a specialist role such as Special Educational Needs & Disability Co-ordinator (SENDCo) or Physical Activity and Nutrition Coordinator (PANCo).

It's a brilliant stepping stone to higher qualifications or a great opportunity to take on a position of leadership within the setting.

What are the entry requirements?

You must be aged 18 or over and hold a full Level 3 Early Years or childcare qualification.

How is it completed?

You'll need to attend five taught sessions; your tutor/assessor will set e-learning and written tasks for you to complete between sessions.

Do I need to be working to take this qualification?

Learners need to be employed in an Early Years setting at Level 3 and be able to work with, or demonstrate understanding in all early years age groups.

How long does it take to complete?

About year.

What can I do next?

- Level 5 Diploma in Leadership for Health and Social Care and Children and Young People's Services
- A related degree
- Apply to work in a Nursery, Pre-school, Children's Centre or School to include supervisory or specialist roles

How much does it cost?

- £200 to those working in Central Bedfordshire
- £800 for applicants from other areas
