CACHE Level 3 Diploma for the Children and Young People's Workforce – Learning and Development Support Services Pathway

What does the qualification cover?

The skills and knowledge needed to support children and young people to fully access statutory education.

When can I start?

Any time.

Who is it suitable for?

Anyone working or volunteering as a learning mentor in the children and young people's workforce for a minimum of 15 hours per week.

What are the entry requirements?

You must be at least 16 years old with experience of working or volunteering with children or young people.

How is it completed?

All units will be assessed using a range of methods. This includes direct observation in your workplace and written assignments.

How long does it take to complete?

Approximately 15 months.

What can I do next?

- Level 5 Diploma in Leadership for Health and Social Care and Children and Young People's Services or other higher level related qualifications.
- A related degree.
- Apply for Learning Mentor, School Attendance Officer or Access and Inclusion Officer positions.
