There are more opportunities than ever to work with children, so if you're the type of person who comes alive around young children, this course can help you take your first step into a fantastic career.

Our next course starts on Wednesday 20th February 2019 and will take place at Dunstable South Children's Centre, Oakwood Avenue, Dunstable, LU5 4AS. You'll need to attend 1 session a week for 7 weeks.

To successfully complete the course you will need to:

- attend all 7 sessions on Wednesdays from 09:30 to 12:30 @ 20 & 27 February 2019, 6, 13, 20, 27, March 2019, and 3 April 2019 (*venue: Dunstable South Children's Centre, Oakwood Avenue, Dunstable, LU5 4AS*)
- participate in and discover how children learn from activities such as making playdough and creating treasure baskets
- complete short written tasks set between each session
- have access to a computer or laptop to facilitate online learning

Learners may be eligible for full or partial funding for this course, depending on individual circumstances at the time of application.
